You are invited to submit your research paper for the upcoming international workshop on CORDEX for East Asia which will take place at Jeju Island, Republic of Korea on 22-23 September 2011. The workshop place will be at Seogwipo KAL Hotel in southern coast of Jeju Island.

The domain for CORDEX-East Asia is the biggest among eleven CORDEX domains in the world.
